

Journey to Killaloe in County Clare and admire its beautiful, picturesque setting on the River Shannon as we experience a relaxing holiday filled with tranquillity in the enchanting surroundings of Ireland's Hidden Heartlands.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Departing our local area we journey to North Wales & our overnight hotel. Day 2: Departing our hotel we journey the short distance to the ferry port at Holyhead for our crossing to Dublin. Arriving in Dublin we enjoy a scenic drive to our hotel in Killaloe. Day 3: We spend today at leisure, relaxing in our hotel and exploring our scenic base of Killaloe. A short stroll from our hotel takes us to Ballina Quay and Killaloe River Cruises, where we embark on a 1 hour circular river cruise to Lough Derg. Enjoy a complimentary Irish or Baileys Coffee/Hot Chocolate on board commentary & spectacular scenery as we take in the views, gently cruising along the calm, sheltered waters of Ireland's finest waterway.

Day 4: Today we enjoy a scenic drive around Lough Derg, one of the most beautiful lakes on the River Shannon, it is also the largest and most southerly, touching the counties of Clare, Galway and Tipperary. We pause in the county town of Nenagh, County Tipperary, with its 13th century castle and striking cylindrical keep. before continuing to the quaint Garrykennedy and its lovely country pub, 'Larkins', located on the banks of the lough, where we enjoy a traditional taste of Ireland, tucking into a tasty lunch of beef and Guinness casserole served with mashed potatoes and tea/coffee. After our lunch, we continue our scenic circular Lough Derg drive, stopping to admire the beautiful villages of Portroe & Terryglass. To complete our day, we visit the small artisan chocolate factory of Wilde Irish Chocolates, where we have included a guided tour & tasting, located on the banks of Lough Derg. Day 5: After breakfast we journey to Athlone. as we step back 1,200 years and join the Vikings in Ireland's Hidden Heartlands. We board our replica Viking ship for a cruise along Ireland's longest river - River Shannon, departing from the quayside at Athlone Castle. We enjoy live commentary on the local history, the religious settlements on the islands and tales of Viking treasure whilst indulging in a

complimentary Irish or Baileys Coffee. After our cruise, we have free time in Athlone "the small town with a big heart" to enjoy a spot of lunch in the array of restaurants or meander around the quirky shops set amongst the ancient streets and alleys. Walking around the town, it feels like every building has a story, from the 12th century castle, to the 17th century barracks, to the 19th century workhouse, a remnant from famine-era Ireland.

Day 6: Sadly we bid farewell to Ireland and travel to the port of Dublin for our ferry crossing to Holyhead. On disembarking at Holyhead, we make the short journey to our overnight hotel.

Day 7: Departing the hotel after breakfast, we make our return journey with suitable comfort breaks en route, to arrive home approximately late afternoon.

Springtime in Scenic Shropshire

Shropshire is a captivating destination that offers an exceptional mix of rugged exploration, peaceful serenity, and restorative landscapes. It is famed for its beautiful countryside and unspoilt market towns, as well as its profound historical legacy as the birthplace of the Industrial Revolution, evidenced by the iconic Ironbridge Gorge.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Departing from our local area, we journey to Shropshire with a comfort break en route, before arriving at the Mercure Telford Hotel

Day 2: Departing the hotel after breakfast we journey to the finest and best-preserved fortified medieval manor house in England, Stokesay Castle. Day 3: This morning, we travel to Shrewsbury, a fine medieval market town, here we board our boat for a scenic cruise along the River Severn as it loops around the town. Free time is available for lunch and to explore the cobbled streets, narrow alleyways and timber framed black and white buildings. In the afternoon we visit the impressive Ironbridge Gorge where the world's first iron bridge forms the centre of this

World Heritage Site, go back in time at the Blists Hill Victorian Town. Enjoy the sights, sounds and smells of this reconstructed working-class town, complete with a whole range of shops, factories, and buildings, along with costumed characters, going about their daily lives.

Day 4: Departing the hotel after breakfast, we travel to Bridgnorth and the famous Severn Valley Railway for a delightful single journey passing through lovingly restored stations on the way to Kidderminster. Arriving in Kidderminster, enjoy free time to explore this large market town, see the Famous Town Hall a beautiful Victorian building where speeches from eminent leaders such as a young Winston Churchill, Prime Minister Stanley Baldwin, explorer Earnest Shackleton and women's rights campaigner Emmeline Pankhurst have echoed off its walls. We re-join the coach, and continue our journey to Bewdley, a beautiful Georgian riverside town which retains its unique charm. Enjoy free time to explore before returning to our hotel.

Day 5: Departing the hotel after breakfast we make our return journey, with suitable comfort breaks en route, to arrive home approximately late afternoon.

Situated on the Sussex Coast, Eastbourne is a town with grace and elegance that has something for everyone. Victorian hotels line the seafront promenade alongside the colourful gardens, there is a centrally located pier a large range of shops in the town and the Sovereign Harbour Marina.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Departing from our local area, we journey south with suitable comfort breaks en route, before arriving at the Langham Hotel in Eastbourne.

Ireland's Timeless Charms of Westport

Westport on the edge of Clew Bay is surrounded by magnificent scenery and provides excellent opportunities for our touring programme. Many of the shops have retained their old-world façade giving Westport streets a unique atmosphere.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Departing from our local area, we journey to Wales with adequate comfort breaks en route to the port of Holyhead to board our ferry for the crossing to Dublin. On disembarking, we continue our journey to our overnight hotel for dinner, bed and breakfast. Day 2: After a leisurely breakfast we have free time in Trim before making a scenic drive across the centre of Ireland prior to arriving at the Castlecourt Hotel for our four night stay. Each evening the hotel stages entertainment in the 'Petie Joe's Bar', together with a range of activities including bingo, table quizzes and other themed events.

Day 3: Today is a free day to explore Westport, there is an opportunity of visiting Westport House which was built in 1730 on the ruins of a 16th century castle, if you wish at an extra cost. Day 4: Today we depart for our excursion to the Achill Island, the largest of the Irish Islands, where we take our spectacular drive crossing Achill Sound by the new bridge. This Atlantic drive has been voted one of the finest in Ireland, passing by Ashleam Bay to Dooega, Keel, Keem and Moyteogue Head. The landscape changes from mountains, dramatic cliffs, seascapes and sandy beaches, we see views of the deserted village on this island before returning to the hotel.

Day 5: Departing the hotel, our scenic drive takes us through Murrisk and Partry Mountains before arriving in the delightful resort of Leenane at the head of the famous Killary Fjord, the only one in Ireland, where we include a 90 minute cruise on the Catamaran with commentary, before free time in Leenane.

After lunch we depart Leenane, for our scenic

drive via Aasleagh Bridge and Falls, Finn Lough, through the Doolough valley up to Clew Bay with a view of Clare Island on a clear day. Continuing along Clew Bay we take views of Croagh Patrick Mountain (considered to be the holiest mountain in Ireland) and the National Famine Memorial where we make a break, prior to returning to the hotel. Day 6: Departing the hotel after breakfast, we journey to Galway where free time is available, before our journey takes us across the centre of Ireland to our overnight hotel for our stay. Day 7: Sadly, we bid farewell to Ireland and travel to the port of Dublin for an early sailing to Holyhead. Due to the early start, we have included a late breakfast/brunch as you cruise over the Irish Sea. On disembarking at Holyhead, we continue our journey with an adequate comfort break en route, to arrive home early evening.

A Hebridean Adventure

Embark on an extraordinary journey to the captivating Hebrides, a destination often regarded as one of the world's most breathtaking and unspoiled gems. With gentle landscapes and a rich cultural heritage, the Outer Hebrides offers a serene and unforgettable destination. Boasting some of the best beaches and coastal scenery in Europe, flourishing wildlife, fascinating history and unique island cultures, this tour is, quite literally, a breath of fresh air.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Departing from our local area, we journey North with suitable comfort breaks en route to The Caledonian Hotel in Fort William, for Dinner, Bed & Breakfast.

Day 2: Departing the hotel after breakfast, we travel through the spectacular Scottish Highlands towards the Kyle of Lochalsh and the Isle of Skye passing the beautiful Eilean Donan Castle en route. From the Kyle of Lochalsh, we cross the magnificent Skye Road Bridge onto the Isle of Skye itself and enjoy the scenic drive towards the island's capital, Portree. Arriving at the port of Uig we board our ferry and enjoy our included evening meal as we sail to Lochmaddy, on the Isle of Benbecula. On disembarking we journey to The Dark Island Hotel, our destination for the next two nights. Day 3: This morning, we are joined by a local guide for a full day tour of South Uist, a stunningly beautiful island of the Outer Hebrides, with crystal clear waters and white powder beaches to the west and heather uplands dominated by Beinn Mhor to the east. We pass the ruins of the 18th century Ormacleit Castle towards the Isle of Eriskay, which is linked to South Uist by a stone causeway. This beautiful little island is where Bonnie Prince Charlie first set foot on Scottish soil and is also known for its famous, semi-wild ponies. On our return we visit the Hebridean Jewellery Shop & Workshop, immerse yourself in the rich heritage of Scotland with the meticulously crafted Scottish iewellery, inspired by the mystical charm of its ancient castles, misty lochs, and vibrant tartans. Each piece is handcrafted by skilled artisans, ensuring that you receive a truly unique and authentic treasure.

Day 4: Today we depart with a packed lunch to travel across North Uist, alongside 13 miles of stunning sandy beaches, freshwater lochs and rolling moorland hills, before reaching Berneray. Reputedly one of King Charles III's favourite destinations, Berneray is a small Outer Hebridean island, boasting some of the most picturesque white sandy beaches, remarkable wildlife and a fascinating history. From here, we board the ferry to Leverburgh, a village at the south end of the Isle of Harris, which offers an incredibly diverse landscape. Continuing our journey, we head north travelling on the west coast route, making a stop for photographs as we discover some of the most beautiful beaches in the UK. We take a drive towards the Scalpay Bridge and admire the lovely waterfront

villages before making our way to our final destination of the day, Stornoway, where we settle into our next hotel for two nights, The Caladh Inn, for Dinner, Bed & Breakfast. Day 5: Departing the hotel after breakfast, we enjoy a tour of Lewis with a local guide who joins us for the day to explore the island's stunning scenery. Lewis is the largest and most populated of the Western Isles, although it remains refreshingly unspoilt and uncrowded it is home to some of the most important seabird colonies in the UK and a haven to all forms of wildlife. Travel back in time and witness different periods of the island's past, gaze in awe at the beautiful landscapes as we discover every kind of terrain, from white sandy beaches to rugged, rocky coastlines. During our circular tour, we visit Carloway Broch, an ancient Iron Age fortification, designed to impress and defend and were probably the homes of tribal leaders and important members of the community, it is one of the best preserved in the Hebrides and dates back over 2000 years. Continuing our journey. we visit Gearrannan Blackhouse Village, step back in time and see what life was like in a 19th-century crofting township.

Day 6: Departing the hotel, we board the early morning ferry to Ullapool where we have included a traditional Scottish breakfast on board. On disembarking, we enjoy our scenic journey to our overnight hotel in Sterling, for dinner bed & breakfast.

Day 7: Departing the hotel we make our homeward journey with suitable comfort breaks en route to arrive late afternoon/early evening.

Holiday prices include all travel, hotel accommodation and meals as specified in the holiday description and VAT payable in the UK where applicable. The price of the holiday will not be subjected to any surcharges except those arising from exchange rate changes, transportation including the price of fuel, air & ferry operator fares and tolls, embarkation or disembarkation fees at terminals, duties and taxes (including the rate of VAT). If this means the total cost of the holiday increases by more than 8% then you are entitled to cancel your holiday and receive a full refund of all monies paid except any insurance premium and amendment charges. We will communicate the options with you either through email or letter, with a reminder if necessary. If you exercise the right to cancel, we must receive written notice within 20 days of the date of the surcharge invoice. The currency exchange rate used in the holiday costings are based on rates as at 20th December 2024.

5. IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING

If, after our confirmation has been issued, you wish to change to another of our holidays or change departure date, we will do our utmost to make the changes, but we cannot guarantee to do so. However, notification must be received in writing at our offices from the person who signed the booking form, at least 12 weeks before departures. This must be accompanied by a payment of £20.00 to cover our administrative costs, plus costs we incur in making the amendment. Alterations cannot be made within 4 weeks of departure and any such request for an alteration will be treated as a cancellation of the original booking and will be subject to the cancellation charges set out in paragraph below. Some arrangements cannot be changed without paying a cancellation charge of up to 100% of the ticket cost.

6. TRANSFERRING YOUR BOOKING

You can transfer your booking to somebody else, but the person must satisfy all the

conditions of the holiday, and you must inform us either by letter or email no less than 7 days before departure. This transfer will cost £20.00 plus reasonable costs to make the transfer. You will remain responsible for ensuring payment before the balance due date. This is in addition to (and does not affect) the separate liability of the transferee to us.

7. IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY

You or any member of your party, may cancel your holiday at any time provided the cancellation is made by the person signing the booking form and is communicated to us in writing via the office who made your original booking. You must pay cancellation charges to cover our administration costs and to compensate for the risk of us not reselling the holiday. If the holiday is resold a refund will be made. Your cancellation will take effect from the date on which we or our agent receive your written confirmation of your cancellation. You must also return any tickets or vouchers you have received. A reduction in room occupancy may increase the charges for the remaining passengers by the application of supplements for low occupancy of rooms. Where bought in supplies, such as ferries, hotel accommodation etc have been bought in on your behalf, and where the terms and conditions of the supplier are non-refundable, these products will be charged to you at the full retail rate. If this applies, the non-refundable items will be deducted from your holiday costs and the following scale of charges will be applied to the remainder:

You may cancel your holiday without paying any termination fee before the start of the holiday, in the event of unavoidable and extraordinary circumstances occurring at the place of destination or its immediate vicinity, for instance, if there are serious security problems at the destination which are likely to affect the package.

8. ALTERATIONS TO YOUR HOLIDAY BY US

We hope that we will not have to make any change to your holiday but, because our holidays are planned many months in advance, we sometimes do need to make minor changes. We reserve the right to do this at any time. We will let you or your booking agent know about any important changes as soon as possible, including the minimum number of passengers required on the trip. If after booking, and before departure, we make a major change to your holiday, you will have the option of withdrawing from the holiday without penalty or transferring to another holiday without any charge. In either case, we will pay you compensation, according to the scale set below. A major change includes the time of your departure or return time by more than 12 hours, a change in departure point, location of resort or type of hotel, a change in cross channel travel, or specification of the coach. If we tell you about any of these changes after we have confirmed your holiday booking (other than force majeure), you may either:

- accept the new arrangements offered by us; or-accept a replacement holiday from us of equivalent or similar standard and price (at the date of the change), if we can offer you one; or
- cancel your holiday with us and receive a full refund of all monies.
 Either way, we will pay you compensation, using the Compensation table shown,

IMPORTANT NOTE. Compensation will not be payable if the holiday is cancelled because the number of persons booked is less than the number required, or for events beyond our control, which include: war, threat of war, riots, civil disturbances, terrorist activity and its consequences, industrial disputes, natural and nuclear disasters, fire, epidemics, health risks and pandemics, unavoidable and unforeseeable technical problems with transport for reasons beyond our control or that of our suppliers; hurricanes and other actual or potential severe weather conditions and any other similar events. You are also advised to check with The Foreign and Commonwealth Office Advice Unit regularly at https://www.gov.uk/browse/abroad/travel-abroad prior to travel.

All holidays operate if the minimum number of participants is met. However, in no case will we cancel your holiday less than 4 weeks before the scheduled departure date, except where you have failed to pay the final balance or because of force majeure (force majeure means an event which we or the suppliers of the services in question could not foresee or avoid and is therefore beyond our control).

9. OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO YOU

We accept responsibility for ensuring the holiday which you book with us is supplied as described in our publicity material and the services offered reach a reasonable standard and if you are in difficulty, we will assist you. If any part of our holiday contract is not provided as promised, you may terminate the contract without paying a termination fee and we will pay you appropriate compensation if this has affected your enjoyment of your holiday. We will, however, not be liable if there are any unforeseeable or unavoidable actions of a third party not connected with our travel services (as confirmed in the confirmation invoice and any other information we provided to you regarding the services), or there were unavoidable or extraordinary circumstances, or the lack of conformity is due to a traveller in the party. We accept responsibility for the acts and/or omissions of our employees, agents and suppliers except where they lead to death, injury or illness. Our liability in all cases shall be limited to a maximum of three times the value of the original holiday cost (not including insurance premiums and amendment charges). We accept responsibility for death, injury, or illness caused by the negligent acts and/or omissions of our employees or agents together with our suppliers and

sub-contractors, servants and/or agents of the same whilst acting within the scope of, or during their employment in the provision of your holiday. We will accordingly pay to our clients such damages as might have been awarded in such circumstances under English Law. In respect of carriage by air, sea, tunnel and rail and the provision of accommodation our liability in all cases will be limited in the manner provided by the relevant international convention.

If we make any payment to you or any member of your party for death or personal injury or illness, you will be asked to assign to us or our insurers the rights you may have to act against the person or organisation responsible for causing the death, personal injury or illness. This clause does not apply to any separate contracts that you may enter for excursions or activities during or outside of your holiday. If you or any member of your party suffer death, illness or injury whilst overseas arising out of an activity which does NOT form part of your holiday, we may offer guidance and where legal action is contemplated and you want our assistance, you must obtain our written consent prior to any proceedings (We limit the cost of our assistance to you or your party to £5,000 per party).

If you have a problem during your holiday, please inform your Tour Manager, your driver or the relevant supplier/resort representative immediately who will endeavour to put things right. If your complaint cannot be completely resolved locally, you must complete a Holiday Report Form which can be obtained by your driver or local representative, which you should keep. Our contact number, for unresolved complaints will be our office number on 01636 684036 (open in office hours) If you remain dissatisfied, please follow this up within 14 days of your return home by writing to Emjay Tours giving your original booking reference number and all other relevant information, including the reference of the Holiday Report Form. It is therefore a condition of this contract that you communicate any problem to the supplier of the services in question AND to our representative whilst in resort and obtain a written report form. If you fail to follow this simple procedure, we cannot accept responsibility as we have been deprived of the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem. Should you wish to pursue the complaint further, BCH ABTOT have an Alternative Dispute Resolution scheme and full details are available from them. We will always use our reasonable endeavours to provide a coach to the specification in our brochure or advert but reserve the right to substitute an alternative vehicle should there be unforeseen circumstances. There is a seating plan but, in some cases, operational reasons may require a coach with a different configuration. We reserve the right to alter a coach seating plan and allocate seats other than those booked. Single passengers may be required to share a double seat with other single passengers. When your booking is confirmed, you will be offered the best seats that are available at that time. If you feel that you require two seats, then these must be booked and paid for in advance, at the time of booking. If you fail to do this and it transpires that the seat allocated to you is insufficient for your needs and there is no alternative seating available, then you will be refused access to the coach and any payments made will be liable to forfeiture.

Specific seats will not be allocated on coaches operating a feeder service between joining points and main holiday departure points or on coaches that carry out transfers between airports, seaports etc.

NO SMOKING is allowed on our coaches (including E-Cigarettes) and we do not allow pets or any other animals, although we accommodate registered assistance dogs, but not on overseas holidays.

12. HOTEL FACILITIES

Some hotel facilities and entertainment may be withdrawn for routine maintenance or be subject to seasonal availability and provision of the facilities cannot be guaranteed. Single occupancy of rooms may be subject to a supplementary charge.

13. HEALTH AND SAFETY

In some foreign countries, standards of infrastructure, safety and hygiene may be lower than those to which we are accustomed in the UK. You should therefore exercise greater care for your own protection. There may be countries that we visit that have special medical requirements for tourists. These regulations are subject to change and our clients are responsible for complying with entry and current health requirements. If you are not sure of the health requirements for the country you are visiting, you are advised to check with your own GP before travelling. You are also advised to refer to the Department of Health leaflet "Health Advice for Travellers".

Some people may be at risk from discomfort or deep vein thrombosis (DVT) if they remain immobile on a journey for a long period. If you are planning to undertake a journey of more than three hours, you should consult your doctor, if you have ever had DVT, pulmonary embolism, a family history of clotting conditions, cancer or treatment for cancer, stroke, and heart or lung disease or If you have had major surgery in the past three months.

We reserve the right to refuse any booking in the absence of a doctor's certificate confirming that you are fit to travel. Where we provide comfort stops you are encouraged to walk around. Exercise reduces any discomfort, which may be caused by periods of immobility.

14. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, ITINERARIES, PICK-UP POINTS AND PASSPORTS

We can only provide general information regarding entry, passport, visa, immigration requirements and safety and health formalities applicable to your package itinerary. It is your responsibility to check such requirements (in good time before departure), in order to make your decisions to fulfil such requirements regarding your destination and/or the country(ies) through which you may be transiting through.

Such information which you may need to check includes (but is not limited to) passport requirements including (but not limited to) how valid your passport must be after return date, whether your passport must be machine readable, or which visas may be required for entry such as ETA for UK travel and/or ETIAS for EU travel.

You must check requirements for your own specific circumstances with the relevant bodies as applicable. We have provided a few useful resources below, though it is your responsibility to check and see if such body would be relevant to yourself.

For UK residents booking European travel, you should obtain a UK Global Health

Insurance Card (UK GHIC) prior to departure unless you are able to rely upon an existing European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). For travel to Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland, UK GHIC and EHIC can not be used for medical treatment. Passengers to these destinations should obtain comprehensive medical insurance prior to departure, including cover for emergency medical treatment and associated costs.

We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel, or incur any other loss because you have not complied with any entry, passport, visa, immigration requirements or health formalities. You agree to reimburse us in relation to any fines or other losses which we incur as a result of your failure to comply with any entry passport, visa, immigration requirements or health formalities.

You are responsible for ensuring you are at the correct departure point, at the correct time and with the correct documents. "Emjay Tours" reserve the right to modify itineraries to conform with requests from competent authorities both within the UK and abroad.

15. SPECIAL REQUESTS

All special needs and requests, if agreed, should be entered on the booking form and be included in the confirmation of the holiday. These cannot be guaranteed except, where confirmed as part of our holiday commitment to you and are detailed on your holiday booking confirmation. We are keen to ensure that we plan the arrangements for your holiday so that special needs and requests can be accommodated as far as possible. If you will need assistance or may be unable to fully enjoy all aspects of your holiday you must tell us in advance so that we can maximise your enjoyment of the holiday. We will need to know if you will need special facilities in the hotel, taking part in the excursions or have difficulty boarding and travelling on the coach or other means of transport. Before booking your holiday, you should be sure that you and your party are both physically and mentally capable of completing the itinerary. If you need advice or further information either you or your booking agent should contact Emjay Tours If you will require a special diet please tell us at the time of booking, or as soon as you are medically advised, together with a copy of the diet.

Excursions which are included in the cost of your booking are detailed on the brochure page and refunds will not be made for excursions not taken. Optional excursions booked and paid for in resort do not form part of your booking. Admission fees to buildings may not be included in the price of the holiday, please check.

16. PASSENGERS WITH DISABILITIES

We want everyone to enjoy our travel arrangements. We are happy to advise and assist you in choosing a suitable holiday. It is important that, when booking, you advise us of any disability, specific need or complex need you may have and any special requirements that will make sure the holiday is suitable. If a passenger requires personal assistance (for example, assistance with feeding, dressing, toileting, mobilising) then this passenger must travel with an able-bodied companion or carer and written confirmation that such assistance will be provided for the entirety of the holiday is required at the time of booking. We reserve the right to request a doctor's certificate confirming the passenger is fit to travel. If, in our reasonable opinion, your chosen holiday is not suitable for your medical condition or disability, we reserve the right to refuse your booking. You are responsible for bringing with you the proper clothing and equipment, which we advise you about in our printed trip information. We want you to enjoy your holiday and will help you select an appropriate trip.

17. PASSENGER BEHAVIOUR

We want all our customers to have a happy and carefree holiday. You are responsible for your behaviour and hygiene and the effect it may have on others. If you or any other member of your party is abusive, disruptive or behaves in a way that could cause damage or injury to others or affect their enjoyment of their holiday or which could damage property, we have the right to terminate your contract with us and we will have no further liability or obligation to you. The coach driver/representative, ship's captain, or similar, authorised official is entitled to refuse you boarding if in their reasonable opinion you are unacceptably under the influence of drink or drugs or you are being violent or disruptive. If you are refused boarding on the outward journey, we will regard it as a cancellation by you and we will apply cancellation charges. If on your return journey, we have the right to terminate the contract with you. We also request that mobile telephones are not used on the coach.

18. TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly advise that you take out personal travel insurance for the trip. The insurance should cover medical and repatriation costs, personal injury, loss of baggage and cancellation charges. If you do not have adequate insurance and require our assistance during your holiday, we reserve the right to reclaim from you any medical repatriation or other expenses which we may incur on your behalf which would otherwise have been met by insurers. You must advise us if you use an alternative insurer, the policy number and 24-hour contact number.

19. LUGGAGE

Please restrict your luggage to a suitcase weighing no more than 20 kgs per person. We cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to luggage unless through our negligence. Please do not leave valuable items in your suitcase when left on the coach. Please contact us for our policy on mobility scooters.

20. CONDITIONS OF SUPPLIERS

Many of the services which make up your holiday are provided by independent suppliers. Those suppliers provide these services in accordance with their own terms and conditions which will form part of your contract with us. Some of these terms and conditions may limit or exclude the supplier's liability to you, usually in accordance with applicable International Conventions. Copies of the relevant parts of these terms and conditions are available on request from us or the supplier concerned.

21. ADVANCED PASSENGER INFORMATION
